

Overview

This 'Team Building with Music' workshop will develop communication and cooperation and is suitable for both musician and non-musician alike.

The workshop provides an opportunity for teams to work together to create their own piece of music in a fun and motivational environment.

An interpretation of and focus on company values, mission and work-team objectives will help individuals express their view of business goals through a collaborative experience and elicit a shared and accurate understanding.

Participants do not have to have a musical background to play their part in creating a 'masterpiece' that will not only utilise each individuals strengths and reflect team goals but can be a real talking point and motivator back at the workplace.

Objectives

- To enable teams to get to know each other better and have some fun.
- To develop communication and knowledge-sharing
- To enable teams to recognize and use the strengths of each member.
- To develop team spirit and motivation to work together to achieve team goals

Who Should Attend

- All members of any team at all levels within the organisation.

Content

The content suggested can be amended depending on the time allocation available and the context of the team building event.

Session One: Introduction

- An outline of what the team(s) will achieve today. The focus is on writing an 'anthem' for the company. The right atmosphere is set by a group percussion session to 'loosen up' and the group is split into teams.

Session Two: Choosing The Style

- Each team select from a choice of music styles such as Pop; Funk; Country; Folk; Rock; Hip Hop; Rap; Disco.

Session Three: Getting Into The Groove

- Listening to original pre-recorded backing tracks each group start to 'feel' the song and let the inspiration begin. *Moving and a grooving and inhibited dancing are permitted!*

Session Four: Planning The Structure

- The Session Leader will outline some styles of songs and explain the structures that are used to prepare the teams for their lyric writing session.

Session Five: Lyric Writing

- Team members will start to create lyric ideas and supported by the Session Leader everyone will be encouraged to let their creative juices flow. Company Values and Mission Statements can be used as inspiration.

Session Six: Rehearsing

- Teams practice showcasing their masterpiece for the big event.

Session Seven: Silence: Recording In Progress!

- Teams record their masterpiece and experience the 'buzz' of being in a recording studio-style environment.

Session Eight: It's Showtime!

- Each team present their 'hot hit'. *(Optional voting session to pick the best song).*
